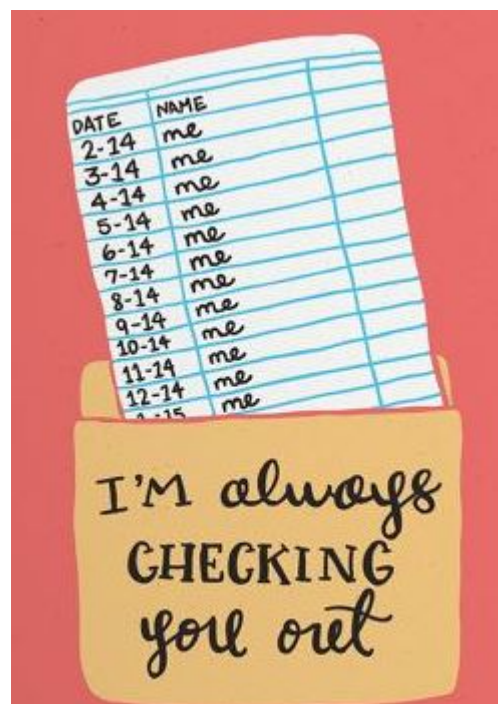
Kimball Library will be closed.

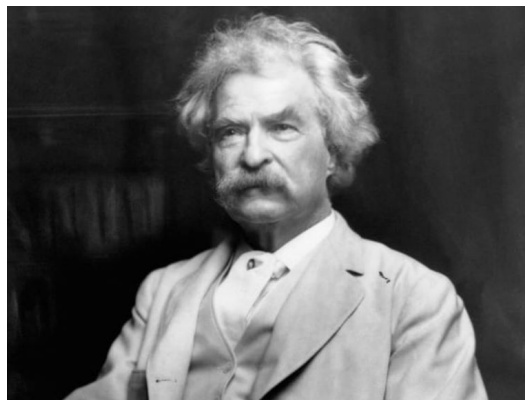
Prince and the Pauper

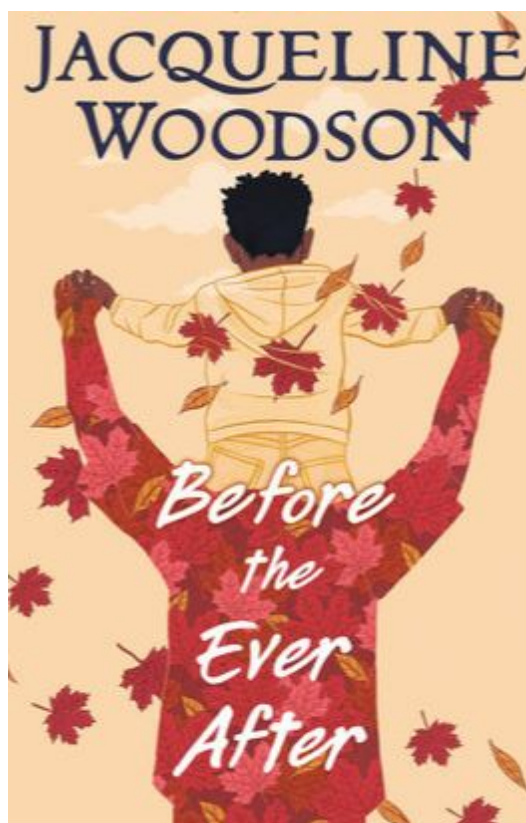
