ADDENDUM TO POLICY STATEMENT FOR KIMBALL PUBLIC LIBRARY

RANDOLPH, VERMONT

(adopted June 10, 2020)

In response to the COVID19 Pandemic of 2019/20, the Kimball Library Board of Trustees makes the following temporary changes to the Policy Statement. The changes will be revoked when community health conditions permit, as indicated by the revocation of Governor Phil Scott's Executive Order 1-20 "Declaration of State of Emergency in Response to COVID-19 and National Guard Call-Out (March 13, 2020)" and Addenda, or another indicator deemed appropriate by the Board.

3. LIBRARY PRIVILEGES

Access to the Library building may be limited at any time, as required by Executive Orders and Addenda issued by the governor, and as deemed by the Board to be in the best interest of community health.

6. CODE OF CONDUCT

- H. No food or drink shall be permitted in the Library.
- I. All patrons shall adhere to the following community health guidelines:
 - 1. do not enter the Library if ill;
 - 2. wearing a mask while in the Library;
 - 3. washing/sanitizing hands upon entering the Library;
 - 4. maintaining at least 6 feet of distance from staff and all non-household patrons;
 - 5. maintaining close supervision of their children.

8. USE OF LIBRARY MEETING SPACE

The Library may limit the availability of meeting space for non-library events. When the Library is available for non-library events, the Library may limit the number of people permitted to participate in events. All participants shall adhere to the Code of Conduct.

11. INTERNET AND PUBLIC WIRELESS ACCESS

- G. Responsibilities of Users
 - 2. Computer use time limits may be modified in order to make access to technology as equitable as possible while allowing for adequate cleaning and disinfecting measures.

13. UNATTENDED CHILDREN

A. Children under the age of ten shall, at all times, be attended and adequately supervised by a parent or caregiver, and not by library staff.
